

How Staff are using Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

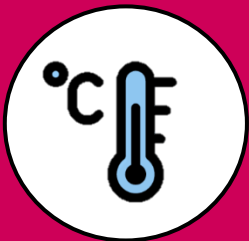
Our staff have been given up-dated guidance from Public Health England (02.04.2020) on different types of PPE depending on the care setting.

3. PPE – GLOVES AND APRONS FOR INDIVIDUAL TASKS



4. SESSIONAL USE OF FACE MASKS FOR THINGS LIKE MEAL DELIVERY, PERSONAL CARE AND CLEANING
